

OLD HURST PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes of the extraordinary meeting of Old Hurst Parish Council
held in Old Hurst Village Hall on Wednesday 18th June 2014.

Councillors present: Mr. G. Bull (Acting Chairman), Mr. M. Fox, Mrs. G. Godby, Mr. E. Jones, Mrs. J. Pearce & Mrs. E. Taylor.

Also present: Mrs. D. Benham (Clerk) and 2 parishioners.

1. **Apologies for absence:** Cllr. L Sawyer (personal).

2. **Declarations of interest:** None declared. Cllr. Bull had contacted the Monitoring Officer to confirm that although most councillors knew the applicants, who are well known in the village, nobody had a close relationship requiring a declaration of interest.

3. **Public participation:** Concerns regarding parking and potential noise nuisance were raised.

4. **To agree the Parish Council's response to planning application 1400509FUL, Erection of function barn following demolition of existing agricultural storage barn, Church Farm, Church Street, Old Hurst, PE28 3AF:**

Cllr. Bull proposed that the Parish Council should recommend refusal. Seconded by Cllr. Pearce and unanimously agreed. Reasons given included: A lack of increased on-site parking, potential increased parking on Church Street, potential noise nuisance caused by music from the venue, potential noise nuisance caused by attendees and staff leaving late at night, potential noise nuisance and disturbance caused by attendees outside the venue, potential noise nuisance from increased traffic on Church Street. Councillors were also concerned that there was no information within the application regarding hours of operation.
